

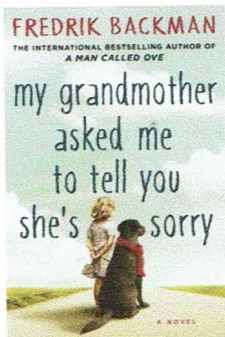

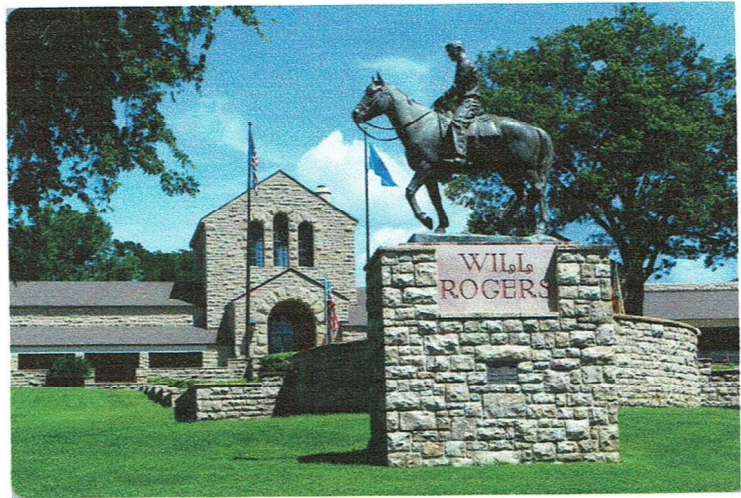

APRIL TRIP



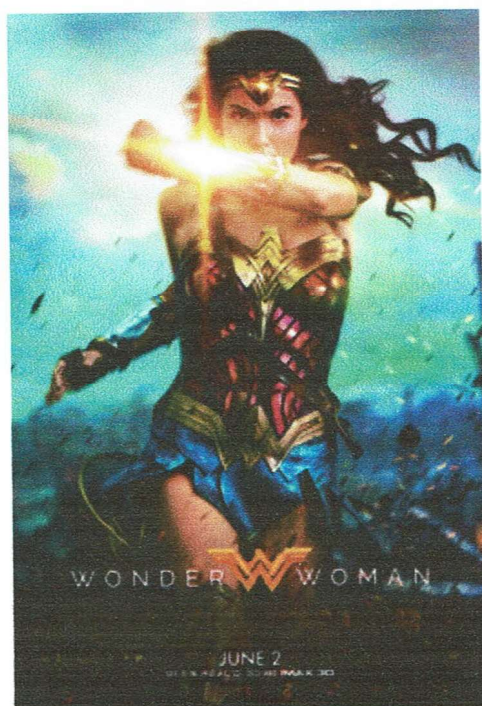
CLAREMORE
