The annual award was instituted in 1990 by the Bartlesville Women's Network. Recipients of the award are outstanding advocates and pioneers devoted to improving conditions in any area of

human life. Their contributions have also advanced the status of women either by direct action through a single achievement or by cumulative effort throughout a lifetime.
