Nominees....

- Family Crisis & Counseling Center, Inc. Domestic Violence Division treats the systems of domestic violence, sexual assault, and stalking. Victim services are offered free of charge for counseling, support roups, protection order assistance, and safe shelter. A batterer's treatment program called Men/Women Choosing to Change addresses the batterers, while FCC's prevention programs provide education and information about our services.
 62 women and 53 children served in the shelter for 2010 213 women were served for other crisis services
- My nomination for the Sweetheart Grant is the Concern Learning Center. The CLC is a 2 star organization, meaning it goes beyond any minimum state childcare requirements. Many of the 90 children enrolled are DHS or tribal clients. Approximately 70% are children of single women. In essence it is a well organized, safe and secure environment that the working poor can feel

comfortable in which leaving their children.

The Concern Child Learning Center receives no United Way donations. CLC is subsidized only for days the children attend. So when illness keeps students away, the CLC must remain open, and pay teachers, yet receive no reimbursement from DHS or the tribes. The CLC relies on a few private pay clients, the generosity of 16 Bartlesville churches that organized the facility and continue to support it, along with donations from individuals, for the past 43 years.

3) Green Country Free Clinic is currently operating in our 21st year of service to the uninsured and the underinsured. We provide free heath care and medications and plan to expand our services to include free dental care the fourth quarter of 2011. Our population includes adults and children; and a higher percentage of women are seen over men.
